Day 1 Check-in Day

Day 2

9:30 - 12:30 War Memorial of Korea | 16:30 - 18:00 Welcome Reception

Start the day at the nearby War Memorial of Korea - a former military site and now a museum dedicated to honoring the military history of Korea. In the afternoon we recommend checking out the nearby Itaewon district or the bustling Yongsan iPark Mall. From 16:30 a warm welcoming reception awaits you with more details about the exciting tours that await you.



Day 3

7:00 - 14:00 DMZ Tour

The Demilitarized Zone (DMZ) stretches for just over a mile on both sides of the border between North Korea and South Korea. As one of the last relics of the Cold War, the DMZ attracts a great deal of public interest and is a popular destination for travelers visiting Korea. You'll also visit the Dora Observatory, where you can catch a glimpse of North Korea, and the Third Infiltration Tunnel, which was discovered in 1978.



Day 4

9:00 - 17:00 All Day Seoul City Tour

Our guided All-Day City Tour is a whirlwind of sights and stops that highlight the very best of Seoul. You'll combine the Royal Palace Tour with a stop for some shopping. After, you will head over to N Seoul Tower for one of the best views in the entire city. It's a lot to pack into one day, but it's a nice way to see it all.

8:00 - 17:00 Nami Island Tour

Explore the picturesque Nami Island with its scenic tree-lined paths and charming gardens. Enjoy bike rides, art installations, and local cuisine at cozy cafes. Experience a relaxing day immersed in natural beauty and tranquil surroundings.



Day 6
9:00 - 12:00 National Museum of Korea | 16:00 - 18:30 Nanta Show

Start the day at the National Museum of Korea - showcasing Korea's rich history and cultural heritage through a vast collection of artifacts from prehistoric times to the modern era. In the afternoon head to the Nanta Show, featuring Korean rhythms and culinary comedy. Afterwards, take an optional evening tour of Myeongdong Market's fashion boutiques, cosmetics shops, and street food stalls. Enjoy shopping, local delicacies, and the vibrant atmosphere of Seoul's popular district.
